


Contract Carrier Program

To become a contract carrier for JNL Logistics, carrier must meet all Minimum Safety Requirements & needs to present:

- 1. Copy of the carrier's Federal Operating Authority. This will be a certificate or permit for contract or common carrier authority showing the carrier's MC number and legal company name. If the carrier has re-entitled, JNL will need both the original and re-entitlement authorities.
- 2. Copy of current certificate. JNL will need a copy of the carrier's current insurance certificate with the following requirements:

Minimum \$100,000 cargo and \$1,000,000 auto & general liability coverage. The carrier's company name (must match the name on the Federal Operating Authority) and current address must also be on the certificate. JNL must be listed on the certificate as the "Certificate Holder".





Flatbed, Specialized, and Cross-Border Transportation

It is sometimes difficult to locate specialized equipment for general commodity or dimensional permitted cargo. Through JNL, you can access a fleet of 4,700 specialized carriers with 103,925 units on your behalf and deliver your freight anywhere in the United States or Canada.

We source the equipment, provide door-to-door service, and can even provide expedited flatbed service. Freight bill payment and electronic ordering are available, and so is customs clearance. JNL gives you the capability to track and trace your freight from origin to destination.

In addition, we handle over-dimensional, overweight or oversized shipments. From planning to delivery, we coordinate every detail, including rate and service negotiations, in-transit clearances, permits, safety inspections and problem resolution
